## I. Eligibility will be based on the following criteria:

- Applicant must either be an employee of a current NFBA member company, or they must be related to, or under legal guardianship of a current NFBA member company employee.
- Applicant must be currently enrolled or preparing to enroll in undergraduate study at an accredited college, university, technical institute, or trade school.

## II. Scholarship(s) will be awarded based on the following criteria:

- Applicant submits a completed application form
- Applicant's field of study could be considered construction industry-related or would ideally support a career path in the Post-frame Construction Industry
- Applicant personally prepares and submits a typewritten essay describing in their own words their educational plan and how it relates to the industry. Applicants are encouraged to include any notable academic achievements, participation in extracurricular programs, clubs or service groups, and any special skills or experiences that will prepare them for their educational journey or intended career. Recommended length of essay: 500+ words
- Applicant submits 2 letters of recommendation
